Prizegiving

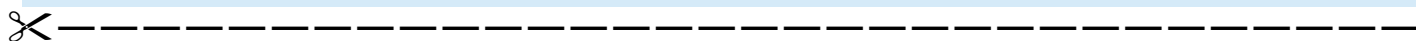
